SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Kiwanis Club of Hannibal Foundation will grant four \$1,000.00 scholarships. They are payable in full to the student upon receipt of proof of enrollment.

Applications will be judged based on achievement, motivation, and educational objectives. Bonus points are awarded for Key Club membership. Finalist may be subject to personal interview.

INFORMATION REQUIRED WITH THIS APPLICATION:

1. Evidence of scholastic ability in the form of college aptitude scores. Applicant must score at least 20 on the ACT.
2. Evidence of achievement in the form of a transcript, including the ratio of the applicant's class rank to class size.
3. Evidence of motivation in the form of a list of extracurricular activities, work experience, and Key Club activities, if any.
4. A statement not to exceed one page in length of your educational plans and goals. In judging this item, phrasing, spelling, appearance, and depth of plans will be considered.
5. Two letters supporting your application from selected faculty representing required courses in the college preparatory curriculum followed by the applicant.
